
Theme of the Week:

Reminder: Please remember to label all of your child's clothing. And please have your daughter wear shorts under her jumper.

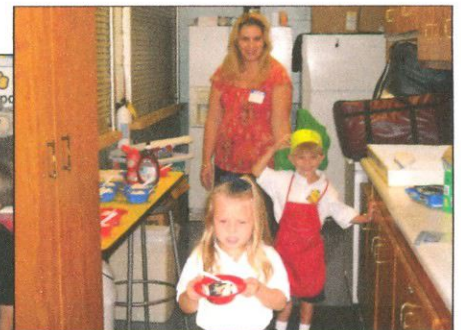
Thank you parents for sharing your children with us. We enjoy learning and exploring every day!
