### Boys

- Shirts - No logos, pictures or words
  - Dress shirts – white oxford with button down collar
    - Sleeves may be long or short
    - Collars must be button down

### Girls

- Blouses - No logos, pictures, ruffles, or trim
  - White blouse with peter pan collar
  - White oxford with button down collar
  - Sleeves may be long or short
- Skirts/Jumpers - school plaid only
  - grades PS thru 3 = jumpers
  - grades 4-6 = skirts

### Boys And Girls

- Knit shirts are to be golf or traditional “polo” style in white or red
  - red with school logo must be purchased from K & M or Lands' End
  - white may have school logo or be plain with no logos, pictures, ruffles, or trim
  - sleeves may be long or short
  - with collar
- Turtle necks (full collar, not mock)
  - red with school logo must be purchased from K & M or Lands' End
  - white – plain
- Slacks – navy blue only with straight legs (flat front or Docker style only)
  - no leggings, knits, elastic bottoms, cargo pants (front or side leg pockets), flares, extra buttons, decorations or corduroy
- Sweaters- plain, solid navy blue or white
  - slipover, vest, V-neck, button
- T-shirts – navy blue with school name and Blue Ribbon logo (purchased through the school)
- Sweatshirt – navy blue with school name over a collared shirt (purchased at K & M)
- Fleece sweatshirts – pull over the head with ¼ zipper – navy blue with school logo for PreSchool through 6<sup>th</sup>  
red with school logo for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders  
(purchased at K & M or Lands' End)
- Shorts – navy blue, knee length (flat front or Docker style), no knit or cargo style
  - Worn August to October 31<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup> to the last day of school in June
- Socks – plain navy blue or white crew or “bobby socks” with 3 inch ribbing, no lace, ribbon or trim
  - navy blue or white tights and knee socks
  - socks are worn with all shoes
- Belts – navy blue, brown, or black in solid colors (no designs) worn with slacks/shorts with belt loops
- Shoes – plain navy blue, white, gray, light blue, brown or black
  - Yes – saddle shoes, deck shoes, loafers, tennis shoes, bucks
    - laces to be plain white or black
  - No – jellies, boots, open toed shoes, Crocs, shoes with lights, sandals, faddish shoes, high top tennis shoes or skate shoes (with or without skates)
- Hair – no unusual or fad cuts which draw attention
  - Boys - bangs are to be above the eyebrows, hair off the collar and above the ears, no shaggy cuts, no dyed hair, hair must be combed and neat at all times
  - Girls - bangs are to be above the eyebrows, no dyed hair, no shaggy cuts, hair must be combed and neat at all times

## FULL DRESS UNIFORM

- Girls - jumper or skirt with white oxford shirt or blouse  
Boys - white dress shirt with school tie and long, navy pants (**no shorts**)

### Miscellaneous

- All attire must be neat, clean, not faded and appropriately sized. Baggy styles are not permitted.
- Any T-shirt worn underneath a knit or dress shirt must be solid white.
- All shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- No shirts or pants with any holes.

### Physical Education

Grades PS thru 3<sup>rd</sup> must wear tennis shoes (with laces or velcro) on P.E. days.

- Girls must wear shorts and/or slacks (according) to what is acceptable for that time of the year.

Grades 4 – 6 required P.E. uniform purchased only at K & M Uniforms

- SJN P.E. shorts of appropriate fit
- SJN P.E. shirts
- tennis shoes with laces or velcro
- in cold weather SJN sweat pants may be worn for P.E.
- all P.E. clothes must be brought to school in **a SJN gym bag**

### Restrictions

#### Boys

- no hats are to be worn or brought to school
- no earrings, necklaces, bracelets, or rings

#### Girls

- no hats are to be worn or brought to school
- pierced ears (one simple stud in each ear)
- no dangle earrings, rings, bracelets, necklaces, colored finger nail polish, fake nails or makeup
- hair bows, ribbons, and head bands must be simple, solid navy blue, white, red, or school plaid

### Dress Code Violations

Any student not dressed in accordance of dress code will receive a dress code violation form, resulting in a demerit. The consequences per semester for dress code violations are:

First demerit - warning

Second demerit - isolated lunch

Third demerit - detention
